Day 1 (Arrival Day):

On arrival in Srinagar, you will be greeted at the airport by one of our friendly local "Wild Snow" transport team who will help load your gear into our vehicle. If you arrive early, you are welcome to stay on one of our houseboats on the Lake. Once everyone is together, we will head to Tangmarg Village to pick up some basic supplies before transferring into a 4x4 with chains for getting up to the snowy Gulmarg village. Upon arrival at the hotel, you will be greeted with a hot Kashmir tea and a friendly welcome. This is a great opportunity to get to know Lyall Crump and your fellow skiing enthusiasts or have a short rest before the start of the clinic.

Day 2:

We will begin the day with avalanche transceiver training and familiarization, which will take place at the top of Phase 1. Lyall will take you through the basics of avalanche safety and how to use your transceiver in case of an emergency. After this, we will head up the gondola and do a day of skiing, where Lyall will be observing your technique and offering initial tips to help improve your skiing.

Day 3 - 13:

Over the next 11 days, you will have the chance to further improve your skiing skills with daily lessons from Lyall Crump, a highly experienced and respected ski instructor. You will be in a small group, allowing for personalized pacing and challenge. It's all about improving as we make our way through the mountain's unforgettable powder or on-piste terrain. A few examples of daily lessons and outings include:

- Exploring the mountain with Lyall, who will be offering personalized tips on technique and strategy to help you improve your skiing.
- Working on specific areas of your skiing, such as powder skiing, steep terrain, and tree skiing.
- Taking advantage of Gulmarg's unique terrain to develop your skiing skills, including powder skiing, carving, and off-piste skiing.

Lyall's teaching approach is all about building confidence and providing a safe and fun environment for you to develop your skiing skills. With his vast experience, you can be sure that you are learning from one of the best ski instructors in the world.

Day 14:

After a good day skiing in the morning, you will be picked up from the hotel and taken to Lake Dal, Srinagar, where you will jump onto a Shikara (a small boat) and be paddled to your floating accommodation, a houseboat on the lake. Sit with a cup of Kashmiri tea as the sun sets and listen to the evening prayer echoing across the lake before enjoying your final dinner of local cuisine. These houseboats were frequented by the British in the early 20th century and became popular in the 60's. They are intricately carved and a unique experience not to be missed!

Day 15:

Following breakfast on the houseboat, the morning is yours to relax on the houseboat or you can take a Shikara to check out the floating flower and vegetable market on the lake. The early morning sight of vendors assembling their boats for the day's sale is worth capturing. You can also get authentic saffron here to remind you of your trip when cooking back home.

One of our friendly local "Wild Snow" transport team will take you to Srinagar airport.
